Today fashion is global. Different countries still have traditional styles, but major fashion brands now sell clothes all over the world. From U.S.A. and U.K. to South America and Southeast Asia, you can find almost the <u>A</u> brands and styles. However, to sell in different countries, brands must think about <u>B</u> cultures.

Today many global fashion brands are interested in the Muslim market. Muslims are people who believe in Islam*. About 1.6 billion people, or about C% of the world's population today, are Muslims. Muslims around the world spend about \$1.6 trillion* on food, clothing and other products. This number will grow every year.

UNIQLO decided to make clothes that are inspired* by Muslim culture. They created a new collection with Hana Tajima, a British designer with Japanese roots. She designed long dresses, coats, and head coverings, called <u>Dhijabs</u>, with beautiful colors and patterns*. The designs had to be loose-fitting* and cover the hair and skin. These clothes can be worn by Muslims as well as women in other cultures and religions*. For example, hijabs with beautiful colors can be used around the head, the neck, and shoulders. Other brands such as Burberry and Tommy Hilfiger are also selling these kinds of clothing.

At first, UNIQLO's items were sold in Southeast Asian countries such as Indonesia and Malaysia. ⁽²⁾<u>They became so popular that UNIQLO started selling</u> <u>them in other countries, too.</u> For people around the world, more fashion choices mean more freedom and enjoyment of life.
